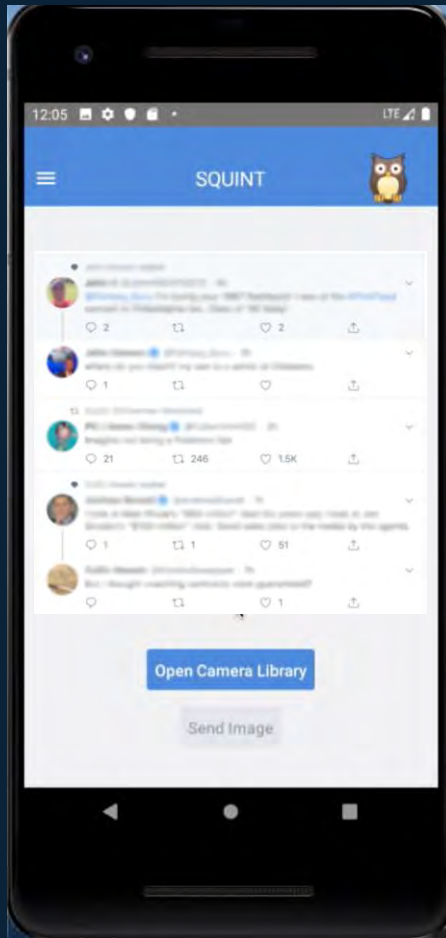
# The integrity of elections is critical to the safety, stability, and well-being of our nation.

Until now, there has been no systematic way for state and local election officials to identify and understand misinformation, disinformation, or inappropriate foreign influence that is circulating within their voting population.

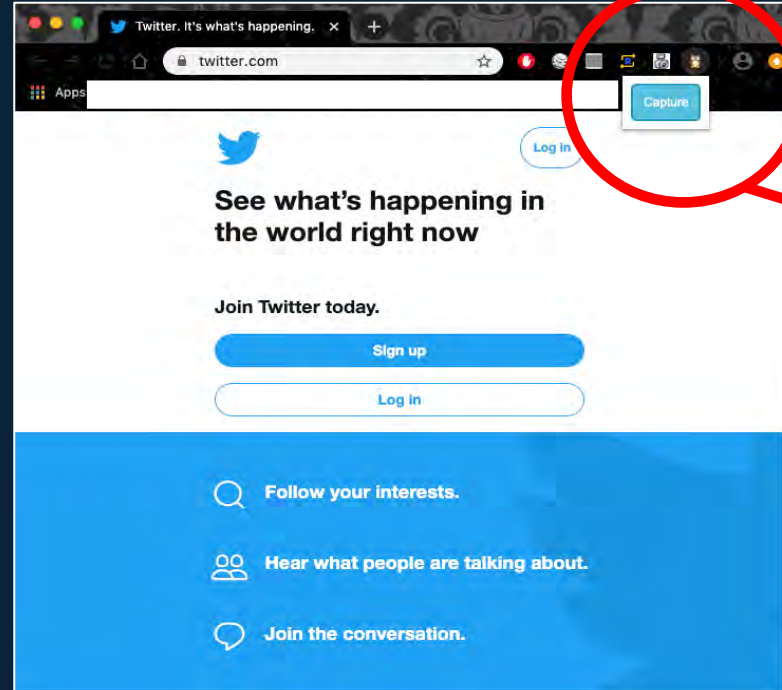
MITRE Social See-Something Say-Something – **SQUINT** – enables rapid social media situational awareness for state and local election officials.



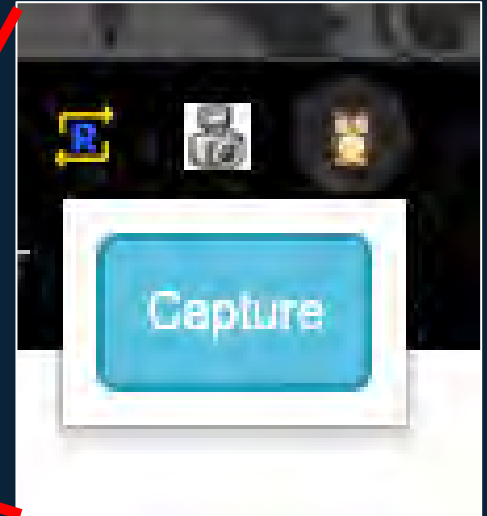
# SQUINT: Both an App and a Browser Plug-in

# What Should Be Reported?

Information about election operations, management, or infrastructure that...

- Is factually wrong
- Seems like it is probably wrong
- Directing users to counterfeit material or to a site falsely claiming to be an official government site

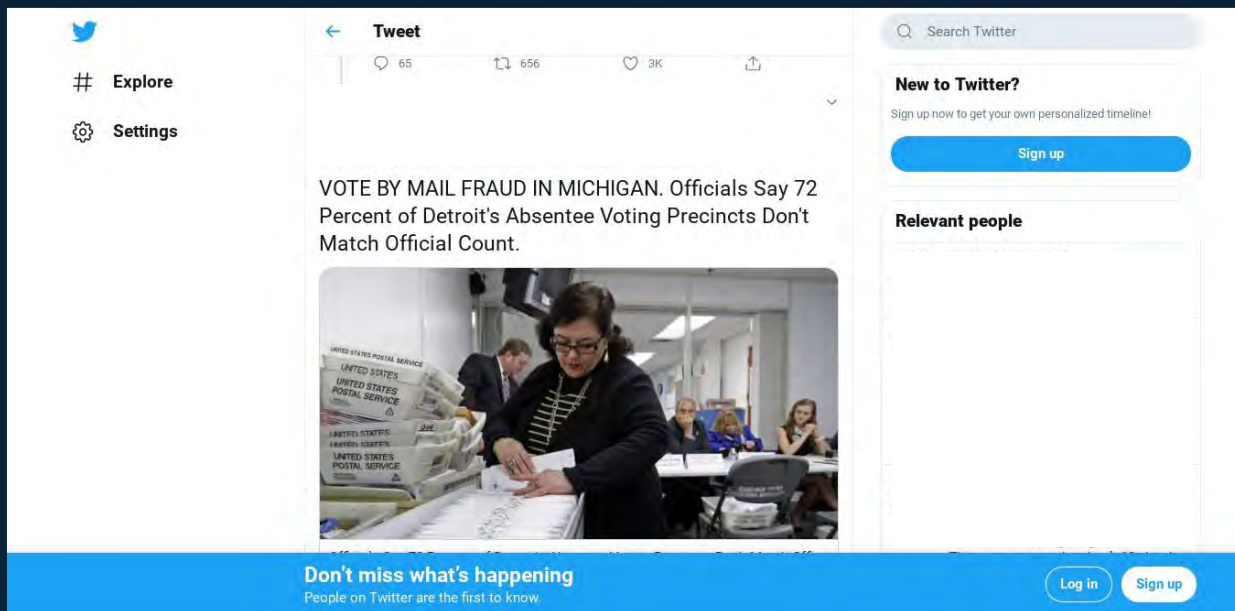
## Examples

- "Voter registration is closing early this year"
- "Reid School Polling Place will be closed for the upcoming election" (when Reid School has traditionally been a regular polling place)
- "Vote by text! Send a message to....."
- "Identification laws for voters have changed, and you will not be allowed to vote unless ...."
- "Check out these voting facts at [URL similar to official URL (www.state.us.gov.ru)]"

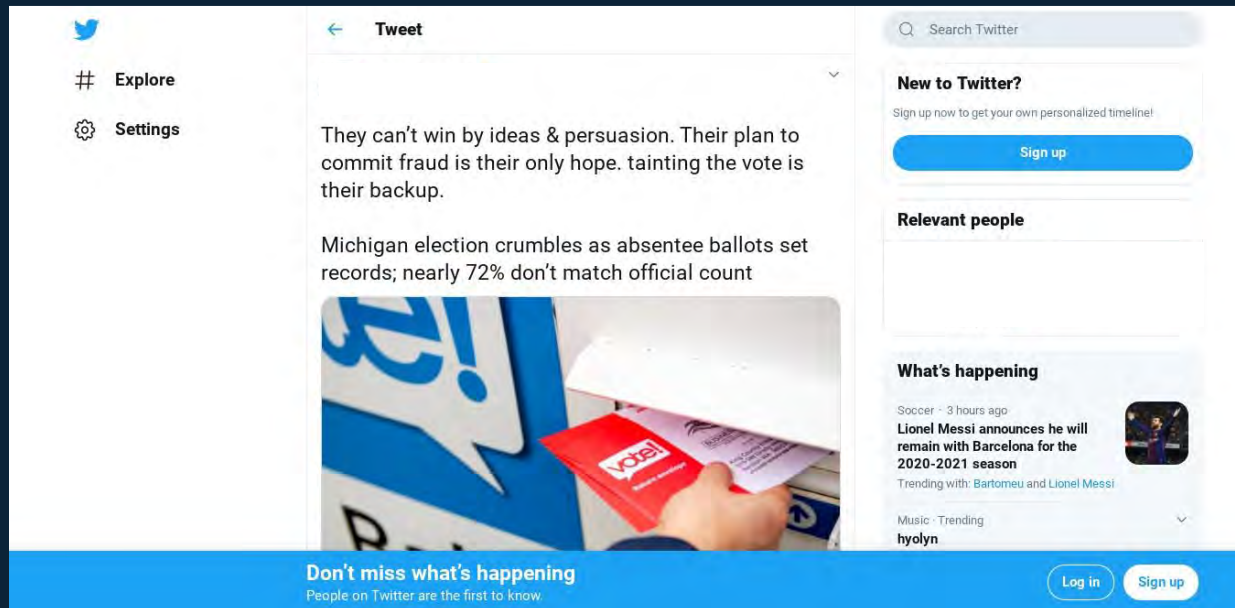
